

Game Statements

Statement to be read by officials before each contest:

The Front Range Christian Athletic Association requires officials to enforce all rules regarding unsportsmanlike conduct by players and coaches. Specifically, trash talking, taunting, baiting, demeaning celebrations, and vulgar or profane language may be penalized without warning. Fighting or other malicious contact will result in an ejection. If any coach protests a penalty for unsportsman-like conduct, he or she is subject to being ejected from the contest. The coach is entitled to an explanation by the official of the incident that occurred. We have been instructed that it is not necessary to issue warnings during the contest. It is strongly suggested that you remind your teammates of this policy.

Statement to be announced, e.g., PA system, before each contest:

The Front Range Christian Athletic Associate and (name of host school) encourage and promote good sportsmanship by athletes, coaches, and spectators. Profanity, racial or ethnic comments, or other intimidating actions directed at officials, athletes, coaches, or other spectators will not be tolerated and are grounds for removal from the site of competition. Remember to cheer for your team and not against the other team or officials.
